Sexual Misconduct Reporting Process

Victims of sexual misconduct have rights. In the event of an on-campus or off-campus sexual misconduct-related incident, students and employees at Maria College are encouraged to immediately report the incident.

Options for Reporting Sexual Misconduct

1. Report confidentially. Maria's on-campus confidential resource is Deb Corrigan, LCSW, Director of Counseling Services.
2. Report anonymously. Individuals can fill out an incident report form (located on Maria's website Title IX page and in various campus administrative offices). Reports can be filed anonymously over the phone by calling (518) 514-7050.
3. Report to a College Official or to Campus Security. All Maria employees, with the exception of the College's confidential resources, have a duty to report violations of the Sexual Misconduct Policy to a Title IX Coordinator and/or public safety, who will take appropriate action.
4. Report to local law enforcement. Sexual misconduct is prohibited, in separate ways, by New York State Law and Maria College policy. Thus, offenders may be prosecuted under New York State criminal statutes and subject to disciplinary action by the College.

Victims/survivors and witnesses to misconduct are encouraged to take advantage of emotional support services, including Maria's Counseling Services.

If you are a victim, take immediate action:

1. Above all, be safe. Go to a safe place such as a friend or family member's home.
2. Report the incident using any of the avenues listed above. Tell your story soon to avoid forgetting details. Depending on the incident, these details may be used later in a court of law.
3. Surround yourself with people who care.
