Community Resources

Several community resources, outside of Maria College, are available to provide ongoing information and support to people who have experienced sexual harassment or sexual misconduct, including sexual assault and domestic or dating violence.

While members of the campus community are strongly encouraged to inform Maria College's Title IX Coordinator if they have experienced sexual misconduct in any of its forms, they also have the option of not notifying the College. Those who do report will be offered support, informed of their rights, and be provided with resources on campus and in the wider community.
