

Nelnet: Online Bill Pay & Payment Plans

Maria College has partnered with Nelnet Campus Commerce to offer our students online bill pay and payment plan options. This new system offers students access to their account information in real time*, same day payment posting, separate log-in for non-student payers, and online management of accounts, including monthly payment plan options.
