

Investigation of Violent Felony Offenses

Pursuant to Article 129-A of the New York State Education Law, Mafia College has adopted this policy for the investigation of violent felony offenses that occur on the Maria College campus. In all cases where a violent felony offense has occurred or is alleged to have occurred on the Maria College campus the College will immediately notify 911 and the Albany City Police Department. All College personnel will cooperate fully with police authorities in investigating the alleged offense. "Violent felony offenses" include: murder; kidnapping; manslaughter; rape; aggravated sexual abuse; sexual conduct against a child; assault; arson; robbery; criminal possession of a weapon; criminal use of a firearm; criminal sale of a firearm; aggravated assault upon a peace officer, fireman, or emergency services professional; gang assault; burglary; and intimidating a witness or witnesses. The Albany City Police Department will promptly investigate if a violent felony offense occurs.
